Posters have become an increasingly popular method for presentation at conferences, as they promote greater interaction between researchers and conference participants.

IAMUC Posters will be displayed at the Maritime Conference Center and the Baystate Conference room. It is expected that at least one author will stand with the poster for discussion during each of the coffee breaks:

Thursday 10 October

- 0900 - 0930
- 1530 - 1600

Friday 11 October

- 1200

It is recommended that you hand-carry your poster to the conference, using tubular packaging or a portfolio case. If you need to make an alternative printing plan, please email Linda Trombly, ltrombly@maritime.edu.

You will be assigned a partition in which you will display your poster. Posters are to be portrait-oriented and not to exceed 3' (wide) x 4' (long). In order to hang your poster, a package of clips will be provided.

Posters will need to be uploaded to the [AGA24 Poster Presentations](#) folder by September 1, in order to be published in the conference proceedings. To qualify for publication, poster PDFs must be received by the due date, and the printed poster must be presented at the meeting.
